1 or 2 sheets of Blick Construction Paper 19x27" Sheet (or smaller)

SCOTCH GREY color, cut down to more a manageable portrait size, ie. 14 x 18"

Note: If you have trouble with Blick, the paper is also called "Folia Paper" by Bringmann, 6784 Stone Grey color.

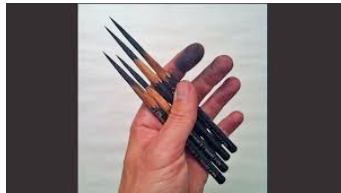
DRAWING MEDIA

2-4 General's Charcoal Pencils – Medium 2B

1-2 General's Charcoal Pencils – Hard HB

1 General's Charcoal Pencils – Soft 4B

2-4 General's White Charcoal Pencils – WHITE (Chalk)



Two methods for pencil sharpening, for the lazy I recommend the sharpener at <http://www.classroomfriendlysupplies.com/> for getting nice quick points, or hand sharpen with an exacto knife like image to the left.

PLEASE have all your pencils sharpened to a very fine point before our session.

OTHER TOOLS

Very soft **watercolor brush** like the ½" Mop from Trekell, link: <http://bit.ly/2svgj01>

Tortillion and/or small stiff bristle brush.

150 Grit sandpaper or pencil sanding board for point sharpening.

[Tombow Mono Zero](#) Refillable Eraser stick.

Grey Kneaded Eraser

Straight Skewer or long skinny knitting needle for measuring

1/4" Foam Core Drawing board.

Artist's Tape for mounting paper.
